1. What two things did the 1st Covenant have? (Hebrews 9:1)
2. The first room inside the tabernacle was called what? What was in that room? (Hebrews 9:2)
3. What was behind the second curtain? What did it contain? (Hebrews 9:3-4)
4. What did the ark contain? What was above it? (Hebrews 9:4-5)
5. What happened regularly? What happened only once a year? (Hebrews 9:6-7)
6. The high priest never entered the Holy of Holies without what? (Hebrews 9:7) Why? (See also Hebrews 5:1-3)
7. What was the Holy Spirit showing us? (Hebrews 9:8) See also Hebrews 8:7-8, 13.
8. What did Jesus reveal about the way into the Holy of Holies? (John 14:6)
9. What does this illustration indicate? Why? (Hebrews 9:9-10)
10. Explore what the writer means by the statement “was not a part of this creation.” Hebrews 9:11. See also Hebrews 9:24 and 8:2.
11. How did Jesus enter the Most Holy Place? Why? (Hebrews 9:12) See also Romans 3:25-26.
12. What kind of “clean” was obtained by the blood of goats and bulls? (Hebrews 9:13)
13. What two things does the blood of Christ accomplish in those who follow Him by faith? (Hebrews 9:14)
14. What does Jesus do for us in regards to this new covenant? (Hebrews 9:15) See also Hebrews 7:22 and 1 Timothy 2:5-6a.

15. What is promised to those who are called? (Hebrews 9:15) Why? See also Mark 10:45.
16. What is necessary in the case of a will? Why? (Hebrews 9:16-17)
17. The writer reviews details of the first covenant (Hebrews 9:18-22). Also read Exodus 24:3-8. What did the law require? Why?
18. The “copies” were purified with what? But the actual “heavenly” things required what? (Hebrews 9:23)
19. Why did Christ enter heaven itself? (Hebrews 9:24) See also 1 John 2:1 and Hebrews 7:25.
20. What does the high priest enter the Most Holy Place with each year? With what did Jesus enter? (Hebrews 9:25-26)
21. What two things are destined for all people? (Hebrews 9:27)
22. Jesus will appear a second time to do what? (Hebrews 9:28) See also:
 - a. Matthew 25:31-40
 - b. John 14:3
 - c. 1 Corinthians 15:23

Application

1. The beauty of the tabernacle was overwhelming and left the worshippers in awe of God. But the most beautiful part of the temple was the Most Holy Place. Under the first covenant, only a select few ever laid eyes on it – but we are under the new covenant (hallelujah!) and Jesus has given access to the Most Holy Place (God’s presence) to all who believe on His name.
