SHORT ESSAYS: ANSWER ONE OF THE TWO QUESTIONS BELOW: (40 POINTS)

1. Name and briefly identify 5 major offerings found in the sacrificial system of Israel.

The Sin and Guilt Offerings were mandatory. The Grain, Fellowship and Burnt Offerings were voluntary.

2. Name and briefly describe 4 major feasts of Israel found in the Book of Numbers.

Passover – remembrance of the night the angel passed over the houses with the blood of the lamb on their doorposts – it lasts 7 days.

Feast of Weeks (Pentecost) – celebrates the goodness of the Lord in bringing on the harvest.

Feast of Trumpets – it presents Israel to the Lord for His favor.

Day of Atonement – the holiest day of the year – when the High Priest went into the Holy of Holies to sprinkle blood in the Mercy Seat to atone for sins for another year.

Feast of Tabernacles – it commemorates the journey from Egypt and ends with a sacred assembly
